Title: Program Policy

The West Hartford Public Library provides programs for all ages that help patrons to “explore, learn and connect” with library resources and with other members of the community. Programs encompass a wide range of offerings: from performances and films to readings and author talks; from book and topic discussions to lectures; and include classes for learning about technology and specific software applications, learning a language, or a craft. These programs draw attention to, and promote the unique resources of the library. Programs will be selected by the staff for their quality and their ability to encourage the use of library materials and services.
