

Fences: This permit applies to any fence that is not intended for pool protection. Any fence that is intended for pool protection must be reviewed by the Building Department and receive a permit from that office.

Signs: This permit applies to the following signs: Signs where only the “face” is being replaced within an existing sign cabinet; banners or other temporary signs; or other permanent free standing signs where the installation of posts is not required. Any other sign installation must be reviewed by the Building Department and receive a permit from that office.

Sheds: This permit only applies to one-story, detached accessory structures used as tool and storage sheds, playhouses and other similar uses and where the floor area does not exceed 200 square feet. Any other shed or detached building must be reviewed by the Building Department and receive a permit from that office.

Decks: This permit only applies to decks not exceeding 200 square feet in area, that are not more than 30 inches above grade at any point, are not attached to a dwelling and do not serve an exit door. This permit may also apply to decks which are greater than 200 square feet but are not more than 8 inches above grade at any point, are not attached to a dwelling and do not serve an exit door. Any other deck must be reviewed by the Building Department and receive a permit from that office.
